

AGENCY REPORT ON APPLICATION DECISIONS December 1, 2009 CYCLE

APPROVALS

Hospice Agencies

Lester Dierksen Hospice – Mississippi was granted a Permit of Approval (POA), **File # HSPA (1264)-10**, for the purpose of providing hospice services to Mississippi County from an office in Craighead County with a satellite office in Manila (Mississippi County). There is no projected capital expenditure for this project.

Bridge of Faith Hospice – Phillips County was granted a POA, **File #HSPA (1262)-10**, for the purpose of providing hospice services to Phillips County from an office at 1133 Hwy 49 West, West Helena (Phillips County). Initial estimated cost is \$48,000.00.

Nursing Home

Lonoke County Nursing and Rehabilitation Center was granted a POA, **File #HSPA (1265)-10**, for the purpose of replacing a 41 bed facility with a new 70 bed nursing home off Hwy 5, west of lots 1, 2, and 3 of Greystone Townhomes and Shoppes, Cabot, (Lonoke County). Projected capital expenditure is \$3,850,000.00.

Montgomery County Nursing Home was granted a POA, **File #HSPA (1261)-10**, for the purpose of adding three beds to an existing 112 bed nursing home. The 115 bed facility is located at 741 South Drive, Mount Ida, AR (Montgomery County). There is no projected capital expenditure for this project.

Hospice Agencies:

Bridge of Faith Hospice – Mississippi was denied a POA, **File #HSPA (1263)-10**, for the purpose of providing hospice services in Mississippi County. There is an initial estimated capital cost of \$48,000.00.

REFERRED TO THE COMMISSION:

Abbey Hill Nursing Home requests to transfer a POA, **File #HSPA (1267)-10**, for the purpose of replacing an existing 100 bed nursing home with a new 120 bed facility to be located at 221 Files Rd, Hot Springs (Garland County) has been referred to the Health Services Permit Commission. Projected capital expenditure is \$6,600,000.00.
